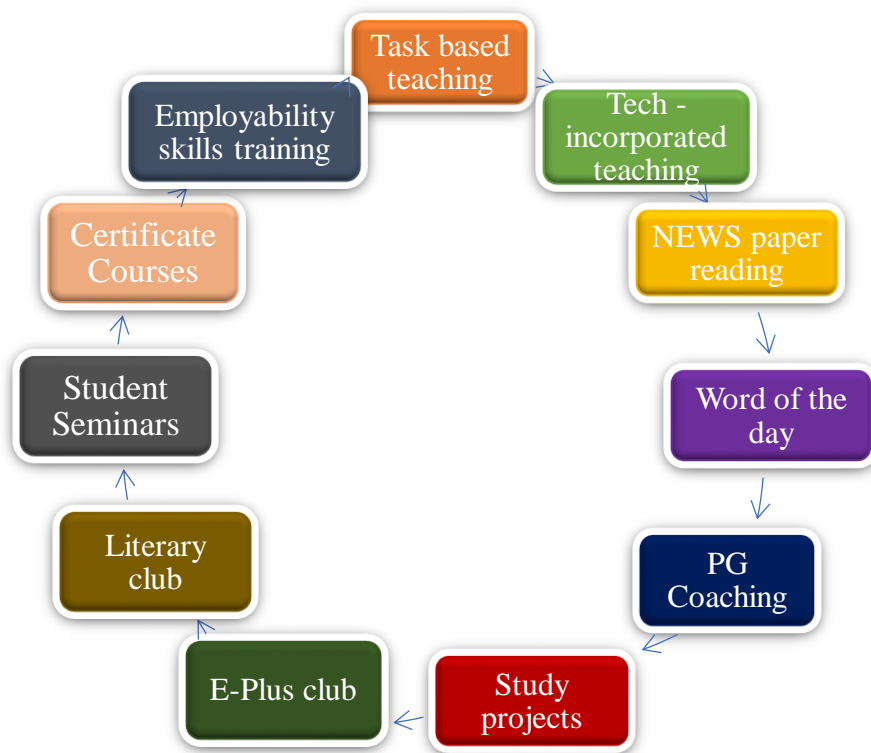

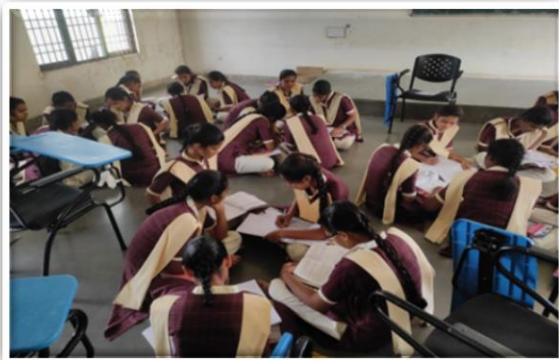

- To equip students with the required soft skills to meet the challenges of the global world

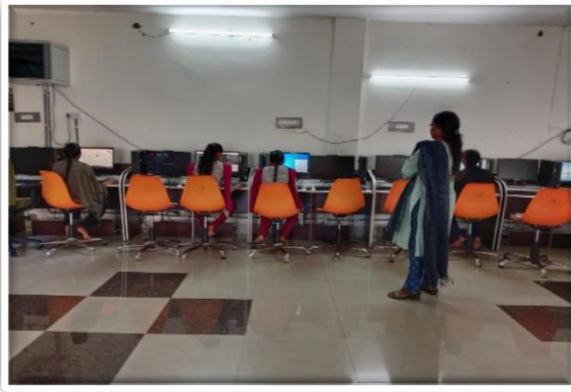
The Practice:

- To provide guidance on effective exam strategies, including question selection, prioritization, and efficient answering techniques.

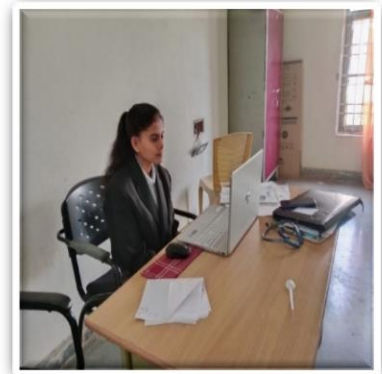
The Practice:

- To help Students overcome their Inferiority and quiver with this type of activities.

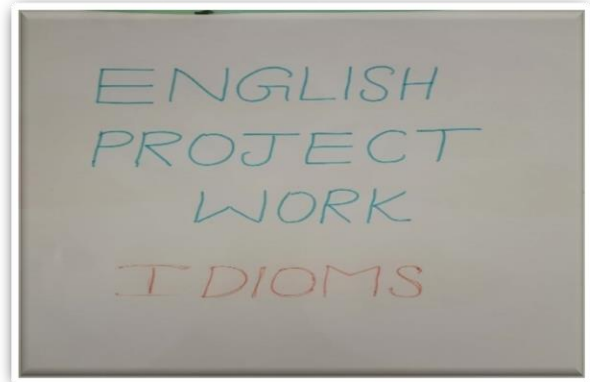
The Practice:
