The principal is conducting minutes for meeting once in every month.





Morning Drill

Morning Drill has been conducted every day from 5 A.M to 6 am under the guidance of army Instructors. Students perform various drill activities such as 100 meter running from Monday to Friday and each Saturday students do the practice of 5 k. m. running. They also do the practice of High imp, long jump, short put, climbing, pushup etc. students are also called for evening drill form 5 pm to 6 pm every day. In evening drill activities students are asked to perform various sports activities such as volleyball, Kabaddi, Cricket all these activities help students to keep themselves physically strong and help to get army, police jobs easily.



Kit Inspection:

Each house master visit dormitory thrice in week. The purpose of visiting dormitory of students by their respective housemasters is to observe bed and bed sheets whether properly orranged or not, to checks bags to find out the unnecessary thing in them. House masters also observe the cleanliness of the dormitory. House masters inquire about the health and hygiene of the students at the time of kit inspection, Housemasters communicate with students about various problems faced by them. All these things help students to keep themselves away from bad habits. It also helps to keep good interpersonal relationship between students and housemasters.



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Morning Assembly (20 Minutes)

The Most important factor of assembly is the wholeness i.e. participation of all students all Degree Lecturers, Vice-Principal and Principal. We conduct assembly form Monday to Saturday from 08:40 am to 9:00 am. We conduct various activities during assembly as follow.

Roll Call: (2 Minutes)

Class wise roll call is performed every day. The roll calls are given by the class leaders duly motioning the total strength total present, total absent and total sick.



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Vandematharam & National Pledge): (2 Minutes)

Students are asked to go for Vandematharam and National Pledge.



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News Reading: (2 Minutes)

Then students are asked for news reading news reading is one on rotation basis, students read headlines of that day and in detail local nation international, sports news everyday for 2 minutes. In charge lecturers guide students in writing and preparing news reading later news is posted on the notice board at the entrance of college building.

with this activity students overcome their stage fear in public reading and know news of that particular day



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G.K.: (03 Minutes)

During Assembly, Students are asked to prepare 10 General knowledge questions to ask students and them after to answer those questions. this is improves their general knowledge skills



Student talk: (03 Minutes)

Two students one from arts one from science are given an opportunity to express their views during assembly every day on the topics such as developments in science & Technology environmental science, ethics & Human Values, importance of Education personality development social activities and also on language & literature. In charge Lecturers help students to prepare students talk this activity help our students to improve their communication skills, stage fear during improvement. At the end of the week two students are selected for best student talk award and they are given prizes to motivate them.

Teacher Talk: 2 minutes

The lecturers speak during morning assembly on rotation basis. They speak on the topics assigned to them the teachers talk is an also individual presentation based on the topics assigned to them. Teachers motivate student through their talk.



Principals talk (3 Minutes)

Principal brief the students guide students on various issues every day during assembly. Principal gives information related academic weekly plan, health & hygiene, self-awareness, interpersonal relation, goal setting, critical & creative thinking, decision making moral values and ethics responsibility of students and teachers in college.

National Anthem: (1 Minute)

Students and teachers go for National Anthem at the end of the Assembly

Disperse (2 Minutes)

The students continue the march past until they get a chance to disperse to their respective classroom.

All these assembly programs foster a sense of togetherness and it has power to develop and make positive contribution to student self development skill, self discipline, punctuality, regularity and also develop personal and social education as well as moral and cultural development.

Special Classes for competitive aspirants

Along with academic classes in morning session we run arithmetic, general studies and general English classes every day in afternoon session.

These classes help student s to prepare themselves for various state and central government jobs like Agniveer, BSF, SSC CGHL, Banking, Police constable, public service commission's exams. We are very happy to share here that some of our students got selected for above mentioned jobs. These special classes are helping students to prepare strongly for combined defense services exams.



Study Hour Duties

Night Study Hours

Students are called for night study hours from Monday to Saturday from 7 m to 9pm. Two teachers are assigned to conduct night study hours one from arts and one from science. During night study hours students read about the topics which are taught on that day. Students also get clarification about the subject doubts from their respective teacher.



Morning study hours

Before the one month of university exams, we conduct morning study hours from 5 am to 7 am. Here teachers who come for morning study hours explain important questions and discuss previous year question papers.



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Holiday study hours:

On each Sunday and on other holidays students are asked to come for study hours from 10 am to 1pm. Here students complete their writing notes, solve exercises of various subjects teachers are also available to clear the doubts of students during holiday hours.





House Parent Duties:

Each section of a class will have a Teacher who will be designated as House Parent. There shall be as many number of house parents as number of sections for all classes in the institution. The House Parent is like a loco parent to all the children in the house taking care of their studies, stay, Health, Hygiene, safety etc., and moulding them as good citizens.

The House Parent is also responsible for the discipline of all the students in the house.

The House Parent should appoint a House Leader and a House Deputy Leader through consensus of his/her house

The House parent should visit the dormitory every day or whenever he/she is free and the problems noticed should be recorded and inform the Principal with remedial measures to be taken.

Medical emergency should be attended and same may be informed to Principal without any delay. Any Hospitalized student is also to be monitored along with Staff Nurse.

The House parent should conduct kit inspection once in a month and maintain detailed inspection report in the House parent register, and submit the same to the Principal. (The Kit inspection shall be done on a same day at same time in all houses by all House parents in a institution)

They should take up counseling in general to the students at least once in a week and special counseling separately for the students who are in need.

They should keep track of the health of children and organize medical assistance as per the requirement.

They should identify slow learners and gifted children in the House and co-ordinate with other subject teachers for academic improvement.

The House parent should arrange meeting with the Parents/Students of each House once in a quarter and see that they discuss all aspects of student with the parents. They should keep the parents informed and take their support and co-operation in the development of school. The minutes of the meetings should be recorded in the House Parent register and should submit the same to the Principal.



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The House Parent shall be responsible and see that all the students amenities like textbooks, note books, bed sheets, plates and glasses etc., reach to all the students in their house as and when the stock is received.

The House Parent shall keep the pocket money of the students as custodian and pay back to students as and when needed duly maintaining a ledger. (record of receipts and payments)

The House parent shall educate the students not to store eatables in the boxes and consume later as it leads to health hazards. This habit is to be discouraged totally. Parents also are to be educated not to bring eatables when they visit their wards.

The House parent shall see that the students do not use cell phones. For any emergency, they have to use phone facility made available by the House-Parent / Principal. Any unwanted literature/material found with students are to be collected and handed over to the Principal for disposal.

The House Parent shall see that RAGGING in any form is curbed. All newly admitted students should be given support & strength to avoid becoming a victim of Ragging. These students are to be educated on Prohibition of Ragging Act, which is illegal and attracts criminal / Disciplinary action against those who commit.

Any aberrations/abnormalities noticed in any House are brought to the notice of the Principal and it shall be discussed immediately with a group of teachers constituted by the Principal to reduce the gravity/ intensity/ adverse effects of the problem (Such as group quarreling/conflicts, theft cases, individual depressions/abnormalities in any sexual behavior etc.,).

House parents should monitor Physical presence of their house students from time to time along with class teachers PDs and PETs and do not allow them to go outside the campus of the institution.

Quest Programme:

The concept of quest introduced in Gurukulam by then the secretary Dr. R.S Praveen sir, the main motto of this programme is to understand the social, Cultural and financial background of the Students who are deprived and are meritorious but struggling for timely educational



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support, due to children's parents are working as daily wage labours in Agriculture. this good program was the brain thought of Dr.Praveen Kumar Sir,. During this program teachers visit Students home and interact with parents to discuss the programmes undertaken by Gurukulam and also seeking the suggestions and opinions of parents for further Improvement. These findings are helping the principals in many ways, in particular in bettering administration and in making academic planning to improve the performance of Students.

While interacting with parents lecturers get a clear vision about the particular student and it will helpful to support the student mentally and to improve her academic activities and personality. A teacher as to visit his students home to meet and interact with his parents and siblings in the hope of increasing connection between college staff and student community. Mock interview

For various jobs, students have to face interviews, keeping this view, we conduct mock interviews for the betterment of the students here students are asked to participate in mock interviews and present their knowledge and prove themselves as best candidate in interview lecturers are assigned their duties as member of interview panel students who perform well in



mock interview they have been awarded with prizes and students who make mistakes they are guided by experienced lecturers.





Essay writing

All students of the institute are asked to participate in essay writing competition. They are motivated and encouraged to prepare and participate. They are given topic for essay writing in advance so that they can prepare well. Three students are selected as the First, Second and Third according to their performance and they are given prizes as source of motivation.





NCC programme

NCC stands for National Cadet Corps, a training program. It is open to the students of our colleges. It's a voluntary program and any student can join it who qualify the physical and written test. This program teaches students to follow a disciplined life. It's a Tri-Services Organisation and engaged in grooming the youth in India to become patriotic citizens. NCC training offers many benefits to the trainees. After attending a minimum of 75% of NCC training, the students get a certificate from NCC according to their level. These certificates help the students to in their career. There are many benefits of NCC certificates, but not many people know about them.

Some benefits of NCC

- NCC is the Indian military cadet corps wing of the Indian armed forces.
- NCC offers training to the students of schools and colleges. This is not compulsory training for all students. The duration of this training program is 3 years. During the training of NCC, candidates get the basic military training. This training is conducted to develop the interest of young students in all three forces; the army, the navy and the air force of India.



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- NCC offers the platform to the students so that they could check their abilities to join the Indian Defence Services. That's why one of the benefits of the NCC certificate is that the candidate gets some relaxation during army selection.
- According to the National Cadet Corps', the main aim of NCC is to create an organized, trained and motivated youth. With this aim, NCC not only creates soldiers for the nation but it also develops the leadership skills in the youth. How to Join NCC? Any Indian student either girl or boy can join NCC.

There are two wings in NCC; The Junior wing and the senior wing. Here are the details to join the junior and senior wing of NCC. Junior Wing: The minimum age to join the NCC junior wing is 13 years. The enrolment period for the training of junior wing is 2 year. To join NCC the candidate needs to contact the headmaster or principle of his/her school. If the school of the candidate is not having NCC training facility then the student can contact Commanding Officer of the nearest NCC Unit for further guidance. Senior Wing: To join the senior wing the candidate's age should be up to 26 years. The enrolment period for this training is 3 years. To join senior wing students need to follow the same process as mentioned above. Joining NCC is an easy process. The NCC authorities also want the youngster to be a part of this organization. NCC cadets get various benefits from joining it that positively change their personality and prepare them for defence services.
