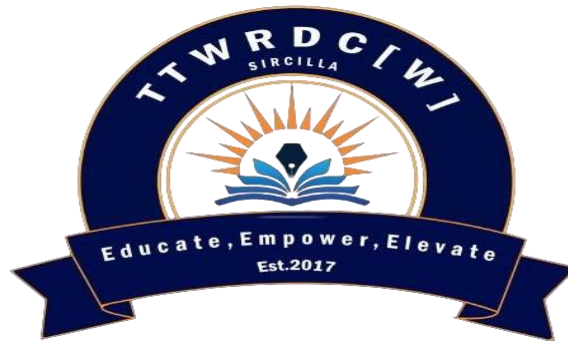

Mosquitoes from an important source biomass in the food chain. Serving as food for fish as larva and for birds, bats and frogs as adult flies and some species are important pollinators. Their bites can cause an allergic reaction through their saliva, resulting in a red, itchy bump. Adult mosquitoes live for about 2 to 4 weeks depending on the species, humidity, temperature and other factors. Female mosquitoes need a blood meal to produce eggs. Life science faculty and above 250 members are participated in this program.
